They implement the rules of the *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* and maintain the traditions of the Roman Catholic Mass Rite. This group provides catechesis (instruction) when necessary to the general audience regarding appropriate means of participation and definition of the different pieces of the liturgy and their importance to the experience as a whole. The Committee is made up of representatives from all Liturgical Ministries (Extraordinary Ministers, Readers, Ushers, Choir, Children's Choir, Hearts on Fire, Flower Guild, and Altar and Rosary Society) as well as members appointed by the pastor.
