

Prison Ministry

This ministry provides the only Catholic presence at the Fulton County Jail by celebrating Mass for the male prisoners on the second and fourth Monday of each month and a Communion service for the female prisoners on the first and third Mondays.

One of the most important parts of this ministry is the important interaction of visiting and dialogue with the inmates. We also bring Bibles and other Catholic reading materials that we leave with the inmates.

The volunteer that we seek is someone who is willing to commit to coming at least once a month to the ministry. Each volunteer has their background screened by the jail and then put on a cleared list that allows them to enter into the jail. Archbishop Wilton Gregory celebrates a Mass for the men at the jail each year and has called it one of our most important ministries.

Both groups meet at 6:15 p.m. at the church and leave for the jail at 6:30 p.m. on their respective Mondays.
