

Ushers



The ushers of Sacred Heart Church are a group of volunteer men and women who serve as ministers of hospitality during Mass on Saturdays, Sundays, Holy Days and special occasions. The ushers strive to insure the solemnity and tranquility of the liturgies. To accomplish this, their duties include:

1. Greeting and welcoming parishioners and visitors
2. Providing assistance in seating the congregation at Masses and other liturgical functions
3. Conducting the collections during Mass
4. Directing the presentation of the Offertory gifts
5. Directing the congregation during Communion
6. Assisting the priests as needed during the services.

Ushers are assigned to a team for a particular Mass (which they select). Information is communicated by usher captains to team members.
